1. About This Policy

This Cookie Policy explains how AT holding, s. r. o. ("ScanGuard", "we", "us") uses cookies and similar technologies on <https://scanguard.tech> (the "Website"). This policy should be read together with our Privacy Policy.

ScanGuard follows a minimal cookie approach. We only use cookies that are strictly necessary for the operation of our Website and payment processing. We do not use advertising cookies, social media tracking pixels, or third-party analytics tools that track individual users.

2. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They are widely used to make websites function correctly, improve performance, and provide information to site operators. Similar technologies include local storage, session storage, and pixel tags.

3. Cookies We Use

We exclusively use strictly necessary cookies (Category 1 under the ePrivacy Directive). These cookies are essential for the Website to function and cannot be disabled without affecting core functionality. They do not require consent under EU ePrivacy rules.

4. Cookies We Do NOT Use

For full transparency, the following technologies are not used on our Website:

- Google Analytics or any other web analytics platform
- Meta Pixel (Facebook), LinkedIn Insight Tag, or other advertising trackers
- Hotjar, FullStory, or other session recording tools
- Third-party social media widgets or share buttons
- Any cookie that tracks users across websites for advertising purposes

If this changes in the future, we will update this Cookie Policy and implement a proper cookie consent mechanism (cookie banner) before deploying any non-essential cookies.

5. Stripe Payment Cookies

When you initiate a payment through our checkout process, Stripe (our payment processor) may set cookies on your device for fraud detection and payment security purposes. These cookies are classified as strictly necessary because they are essential for processing your payment securely.

Stripe's use of cookies is governed by Stripe's Privacy Policy (<https://stripe.com/privacy>). ScanGuard does not have access to or control over Stripe's cookies beyond what is necessary for payment processing.

6. Managing Cookies

Since we only use strictly necessary cookies, there is no cookie consent banner on our Website. However, you can manage cookies through your browser settings:

- Chrome: Settings > Privacy and Security > Cookies and other site data
- Firefox: Settings > Privacy & Security > Cookies and Site Data
- Safari: Preferences > Privacy > Manage Website Data
- Edge: Settings > Cookies and site permissions

Please note: Blocking strictly necessary cookies may prevent you from using certain features of the Website, including the login and payment functionality.

7. Local Storage and Similar Technologies

Our Website may use browser local storage or session storage for client-side application state management (e.g., dashboard preferences, theme settings). This data is stored only on your device, is not transmitted to our servers, and is not used for tracking purposes.

8. Do Not Track (DNT)

Since we do not use tracking cookies or analytics that track individual users, our Website effectively honors Do Not Track signals by default. No behavioral tracking occurs regardless of your DNT browser setting.

9. Changes to This Cookie Policy

We may update this Cookie Policy to reflect changes in our practices or for legal, operational, or regulatory reasons. If we introduce non-essential cookies in the future, we will implement a compliant consent mechanism and update this policy accordingly.
